Is rounded with a sleep.*

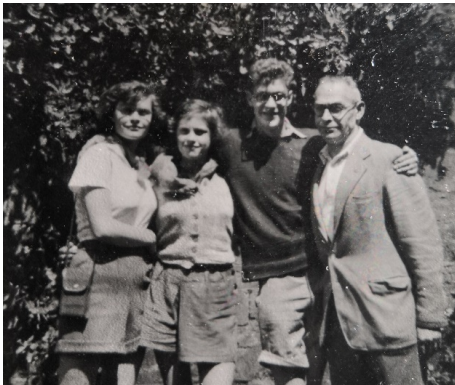

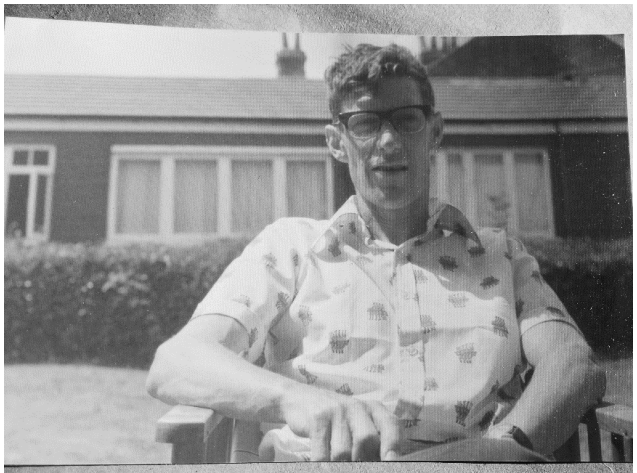
